**IMMEDIATE TEMPORARY ORDERS pending trial**

A request for Immediate, Temporary orders can be filed at any time after the Petition & Summons are filed with the Court. Exception: You do not have to open a divorce case to ask for Domestic Violence Prevention Act (DVPA) restraining orders. In addition, law enforcement officers can issue emergency protective orders (EPO's) at any time, if necessary.
